The same group will be the core group (but also drawing in others to help) of a Christmas witness in the city centre, with a petition of the Evangelical Alliance against corruption, personalised Christmas cards, and an invitation to the church Christmas services.

In the family

When I wrote my last newsletter, Pinuccia, Luca and Mattia were still in hospital. Pinuccia came home three days after the birth, because the hospital needed her bed for other mothers, even though she was still sore and restricted in her movements. But she has recovered quickly and has been back to normal for a while, although at times she seems even more tired and hungry than when she was pregnant. Mattia and Luca spent 17 days in the hospital as they had to grow a bit more – not so much physically but behaviourally, especially learning not to stop breathing whilst they were eating. It was a difficult couple of weeks, running a taxi service between the house and the hospital, but it made our joy even greater when they did finally get home. They have grown quickly, and are a normal size for two week old babies, which is what their age would be if they had not been born a month early.

- For the families of the church, which seem to be under attack in this period with several difficult situations.
