In the church

This year in the Sunday School class that I help to teach (11-13 year olds) we are looking at the parables of Jesus. The first one we read was the parable of the sower, as it is about all the parables. We thought about how we could remember it, and bear fruit, and thought of teaching it to others. So after a few weeks of preparation, a few weeks ago the class taught it to the class of smaller children (3-6 year olds), acting it out with a script they made themselves and using a song they wrote themselves. And it seemed to stick in the smaller children's minds. It was not just an opportunity to pass on what had been learned, but also to learn how to do Christian ministry, relying of Jesus' word and work and not our own capabilities, and praying a lot. This was one of my favourite lessons for a long time, because what I want to do most in the church is train others in ministry, so that I can be free to do other things. And

I have discovered that I can do it with pre-adolescents as well, training and giving them experience in ministry. Maybe in a few more years there will be lots of new Sunday School teachers, and I can move to other ministries!
