Helping a church plant new churches and start new ministries in Trento, Italy

Spring is the season of new life, when we see a lot more happening in church as people come out of the 'hibernation' of the winter months. So there have been good times building relationships with others lately, and more activities in church.

In the church

At Easter, there are two events that we hope will become regular (monthly?) happenings in the future. On Good Friday there was a church service for Pakistani. This is a development of what God has been doing in the church lately, bringing Pakistani Christians to us. The service was for them, for other Pakistani at Trento, some Pakistani from churches in other cities, as well as people from other countries that wanted to participate. They easily managed to fill the hall. **Pray that we will continue to grow in our witness to Pakistani**, as God leads us, to build up his church both here and in Pakistan. On a related matter, last newsletter I mentioned that Ayub's son had been kidnapped. He has been found, but he had been left for dead by the side of the road. At the moment he is in hospital recovering; continue to **pray for Ayub, his son and the rest of his family**.



The following day, there was the fulfilment of Pinuccia's 14 year old dream. When she came back to Italy from Bible School in Switzerland, she had the desire to start up a Kids' Club, with activities and a witness for children. For various reasons it has not been possible until now. But in the last few weeks a team of people in the church has come together to organise it together with Pinuccia. There are a lot of talented people in the church, who created a great program.
